VIP AEROSPACE is a 27-hour comprehensive certification program designed specifically for SDVOSB and VOSB leaders. Topics are taught by Government and Industry experts and include contracting acquisition, strategic planning, supply chain management, capture management, marketing, operations and program controls, and much more. In this inaugural class, participating businesses have been operating an average of 13 years.

VIP AEROSPACE is the fourth VIP government contracting program offered by the National Veteran Institute for Procurement (VIP). Over 1,700 companies from all 50 states, D.C., Puerto Rico and Guam have participated in the VIP programs, including 30 named to the INC. 2020 Inc. 5000.
